

# Homemade Checkers Game

This homemade checkers game incorporates math and problem solving along with a fun game for the kids.

To make the board:

1. Take a piece of paper (the thicker the better) and measure a 12" (30.48cm) x 12" (30.48cm) square. Cut square.
2. Along both the bottom and one side, mark 8 equal points.
3. Draw lines at each of the marked points forming 64 squares.
4. Colour squares alternating white and black. This is your board.
5. If you have a piece of cardboard from a box, cut out the 12" (30.48cm) square and glue the paper to it for support.

Checkers:

1. Gather 36 small stones from the garden, driveway etc.
2. Paint 18 stones one colour and 18 stones another colour.
