Homemade Checkers Game

This homemade checkers game incorporates math and problem solving along with a fun game for the kids.

To make the board:

- 1. Take a piece of paper (the thicker the better) and measure a 12" (30.48cm) x 12"(30.48cm) square. Cut square.
- 2. Along both the bottom and one side, mark 8 equal points.
- 3.Draw lines at each of the marked points forming 64 squares.
- 4. Colour squares alternating white and black. This is your board.
- 5. If you have a piece of cardboard from a box, cut out the 12"(30.48cm) square and glue the paper to it for support.

Checkers:

- 1.Gather 36 small stones from the garden, driveway etc.
- 2. Paint 18 stones one colour and 18 stones another colour.
